Introduction

The Shire of Waroona is currently undertaking the development of the Waroona Community Precinct, with art, cultural and heritage installations a significant part of this project. A series of artworks and interpretive elements have been identified through the Waroona Community Park – Art Strategy & Plan. element Arts and Culture team have been engaged by the Shire of Waroona to coordinate the art, culture and heritage installations with the community and the Shire.

These artworks include opportunities for co-creation between community members and creatives.

The Shire is now seeking expressions of interest from community members wishing to be involved in the creation of these works, and skilled creatives with the ability to lead workshops and fabrication of specific artworks.

Artwork	Description		
Tree Sculpture	A steel, aluminium, or bronze tree sculpture, forming a central component of the community precinct. An experienced lead artist is sough for this opportunity.		
Pathway Mosaics	Water-themed pathway mosaic inlays. A lead facilitator for a mosaic workshop and community participants are sought for this opportunity.		
Murals	Murals on the skate park wall and Big Shed. Lead artists for the murals are sough, as well as community participants to assist in the painting of the community-based murals.		
Carved Timber Poles	Designs carved into heritage poles and bollards. A lead facilitator for a carving workshop and community participants are sought for this opportunity.		
Restoration of laundry copper and plinth	A local writer is sough for this opportunity, to create a piece inspired by the heritage nature of this item.		
Screens depicting Scout and Guides activities	A series of laser cut screens depicting scout and guide related activities. 2D and graphic artists are sought for creating patterns and imagery relating to this theme.		
	A sculpture created from salvaged materials linked to the industries and activities from this area.		
Sculpture from heritage agricultural	A lead artist is sought for this opportunity, with experience creating sculpture from salvaged materials.		
machinery	The Shire is also sourcing materials for this sculpture by community donation. These may include horseshoes, plough discs, tractor bonnet or tractor wheels etc.


