The initial proposal was to include our shire in the Forrest electorate but for reasons listed ascommunity synergies within our neighbouring local governments and the Peel Harvey catchment management , they haverecommended that our shire will remain in Canning

As spring has arrived after a concentrated wet few months, this is a great time of the year to prepare for the hot months ahead by cleaning up and burning unwanted vegetation and the use of herbicides to control grass and weeds. Spraying is perhaps the most costeffective way to limit vegetation growth heading into summer and an ideal way of reducing the fuel load on fence lines and vacantblocks. 
