DRAKESBROOK CEMETERY FLORA AND FAUNA PROTECTION

The Shire of Waroona is pleased to advise that they have been successful in obtaining funding from the Western Australian Government's Natural Resource Management Program for the protection of Flora and Fauna at the Drakesbrook Cemetery.

The funding is aimed at conserving and improving the site, the following objectives will be completed through the funded project:

- Noxious Weed Mitigation
- Feral Pest Control
- · Installation of Cockatoo Watering Station
- Installation of Cockatoo Nesting Hollows

These objects are a positive step towards the end goal of creating a more visually inviting site with a focus on protecting and enhancing the native flora and fauna within the site.
